

A brief overview of how Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) help commercial renewable generators to sell their power and renewable certificates (ROCs and REGOs)

How the PPA market works

1. It starts with **you** the commercial generator

2. Submit your output data to Ofgem to receive your renewable certificates.

3. Sell your electricity, ROCs and REGOs through a Power Purchase Agreement to an offtaker.

4. The energy supplier sells the electricity to homes and businesses.

5. The energy supplier uses the ROCs and REGOs.

To prove they have met their obligation to source a proportion of energy from renewable sources.

As evidence of renewable electricity supply in their fuel mix.
